Police Clearance Certificate (SKCK) Overview

The Police Clearance Certificate in Indonesia, known as Surat Keterangan Catatan Kepolisian (SKCK), is an official document issued by the Indonesian National Police.

It serves as a background check to certify that an individual has no criminal record.

Validity

Typically, an SKCK is valid for six months from the date of issue.

Required Documents

Identity Document Copy

- For Indonesian citizens: a copy of your KTP (Identity Card).
- For foreigners: a copy of your passport and KITAS/KITAP (Temporary/Permanent Stay Permit).

Copy of Birth Certificate

An official document proving your birth.

Recent Color Photographs

- Several (usually 3-6) recent passport-size color photographs.

> Fingerprint Card

 At some police stations, you may be required to provide fingerprints at the time of application.

Letter of Recommendation or Request from Employer or Relevant Institution (if applicable)

– If the SKCK is needed for specific purposes like employment, a letter from your employer or relevant institution might be required.

Stay Permit (for foreigners)

- Foreigners need to submit a copy of their valid stay permit (KITAS/KITAP).

Proof of Residence (for foreigners)

- Foreigners might need to provide documents proving their address in Indonesia.

Visa Fees and Processing Time

- Company Sponsorship
- > 60-Day Visa Approval
- Immigration Fees, and Taxes
- Can be extended twice, each extension for an additional 60 days. Processing takes up to 10 days
